We are offering the programmes, which are now linked to the EYFS, to assist settings in improving their quality. These programmes may now be undertaken in their entirety in order to achieve an Accreditation Award or as individual modules to address specific Ofsted Actions.

The effectiveness of EEL & BEEL when it is embedded in practice has been acknowledged. However this is sometimes difficult to maintain if there are a number of staff changes.

Re-accreditation is offered after three years but many settings do not complete this process even though they continue to implement EEL and/or BEEL on a daily basis.
